Background: Doctors Deployed to Support Cholera Outbreak

Beginning in late 2023, there was an outbreak of cholera in Zambia, which the CDC has called the largest in over 20 years. Team Rubicon was one of the organizations that responded to the crisis by proactively seeking to build a response team in case of an official Request for Applications from the World Health Organization.

Team Rubicon is a veteran-led humanitarian organization that serves global communities before, during, and after disasters and crises. They reached out to H1 to help them find four qualified doctors to prepare for potential deployment.

The Ask

Team Rubicon tasked H1 with helping them quickly build a team of cholera experts who would be interested in deploying to Zambia to provide clinical decision support and serve in an advisory capacity to Zambian clinicians to contain the spread of cholera.

Outcome

H1 utilized their database of 1M+ doctors along with advanced AI technology to identify and contact doctors that fit the required criteria. Within 48 hours, H1 produced a shortlist of qualified candidates to support Team Rubicon's deployment needs.

When Team Rubicon needed to quickly assemble a team of cholera experts for a potential deployment to Zambia's largest outbreak in over 20 years, they turned to H1. Using its extensive database of over 1 million doctors, H1 swiftly identified and connected Team Rubicon with qualified candidates in just 48 hours—something that would have been impossible without its vast healthcare network. Thanks to H1, Team Rubicon was fully prepared to respond to the crisis with expert support.
