





# GRM Turns to H1 Connect to Deploy for Ukraine Trauma Surgery Training



## H1 Connect Identified Qualified Candidates for Immediate Recruitment

## Background: Qualified Doctors Needed for Training Deployment

Global Response Medicine (GRM) is an agile crisis response team that provides humanitarian aid globally. They provide emergency medical care globally to vulnerable populations impacted by war, conflict or disaster

It is common for non-governmental organizations (NGOs) like GRM to encounter a challenge in finding willing, qualified healthcare professional (HCPs) volunteers at times of deployment. This has created a need for NGOs to build a "ready reserve" roster of at least 5 HCPs for every 1 position to ensure they can staff teams rapidly.

## The Ask

GRM was looking for two qualified trauma or general surgeons to provide training for a trauma surgery skills course in Ukraine. They reached out to H1 Connect to assist with identifying HCPs who could meet the need and be able to deploy within two weeks.



## Outcome

After reviewing the profiles of qualified HCPs, H1 Connect identified two doctors for deployment within 72 hours of the request. Within the week, GRM confirmed and deployed the selected physicians for their trauma skills training course.




## What Is H1 Connect?
